CLINICAL EDUCATION, **IMPLANTOLOGY**

We ask participants to be present at our clinics to follow our activities in order to:

- Be in contact with the ergonomics of a rehabilitation centre;
- Actively and passively attend surgical procedures and consultations.

Your regular presence is important to improve your progression curve.

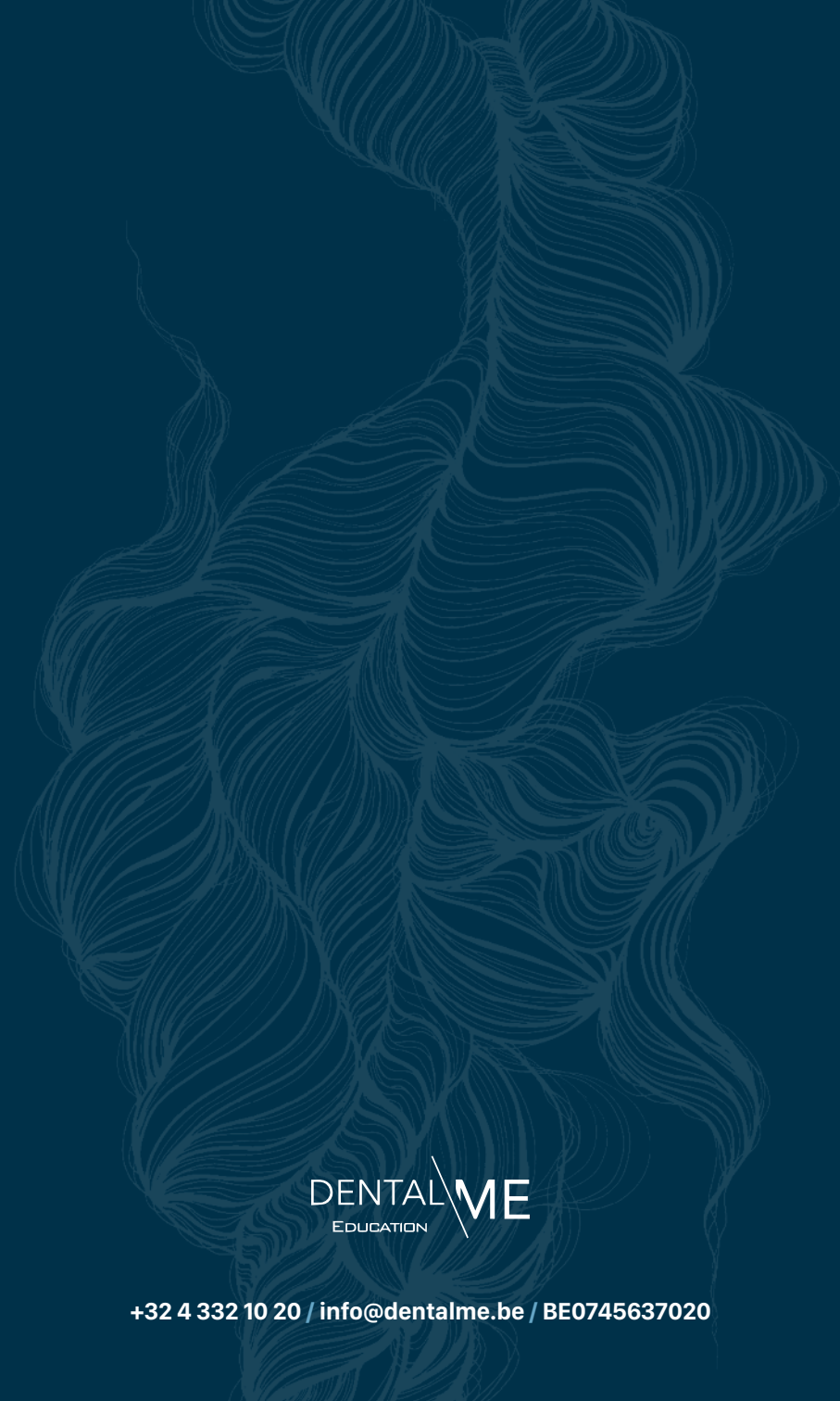
